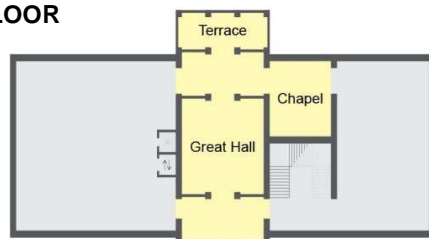

The Bierstube can be found in the Schloss basement.

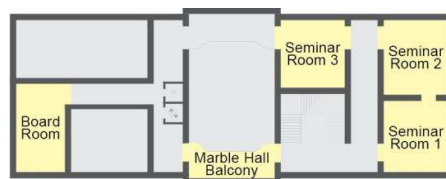

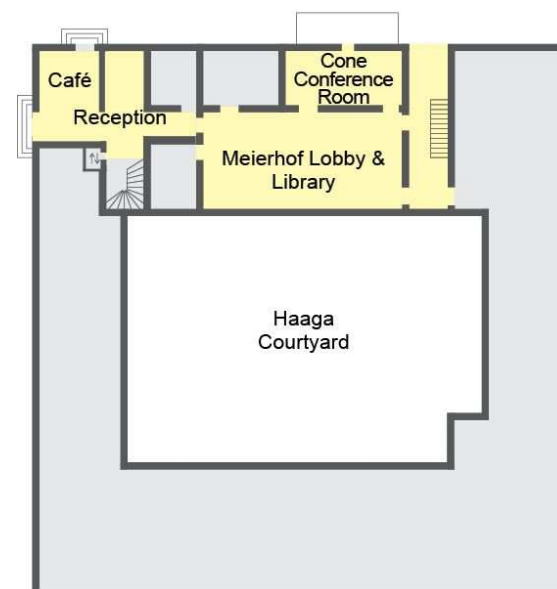

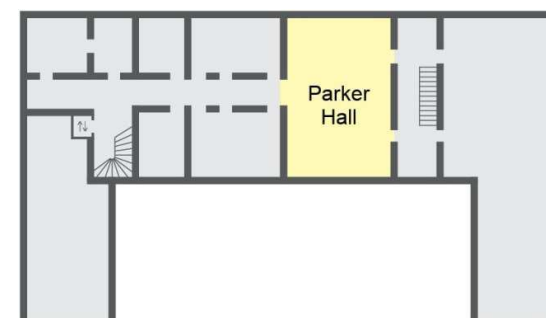
